OBITUARY REFERENCE

MR. CHAIRMAN: Hon'ble Members, I refer with profound sorrow to the passing away of Dr. Raj Bahadur Gour, a former Member of this House, on the 7th of October 2011, at the age of 91 years.

Born in Hyderabad, in July 1920, Dr. Gour had his education at Government High School, Chaderghat; Osmania University; and Osmania Medical College.

A doctor by profession, Dr. Raj Bahadur Gour was associated with Trade Union movement in Andhra Pradesh and was instrumental in building up the working class movement in the State and the country. He served as Secretary of the All India Trade Union Congress. He also had a few publications to his credit.

Dr. Raj Bahadur Gour represented the State of Andhra Pradesh in this House, for two terms from April 1952 to April 1956 and again from April 1956 to April 1962.
